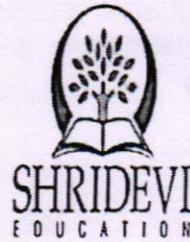

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU,  
THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

#### CLAUSE 1 CO- OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. #### CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

### CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

### CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid for a period of 2 years until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period, either parties, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of either parties after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 60 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations





The student of ECE department department has participated in the event. The resource person has Explained about the importance of Automàtion Using PLC and career opportunities in the area of industrial automation.

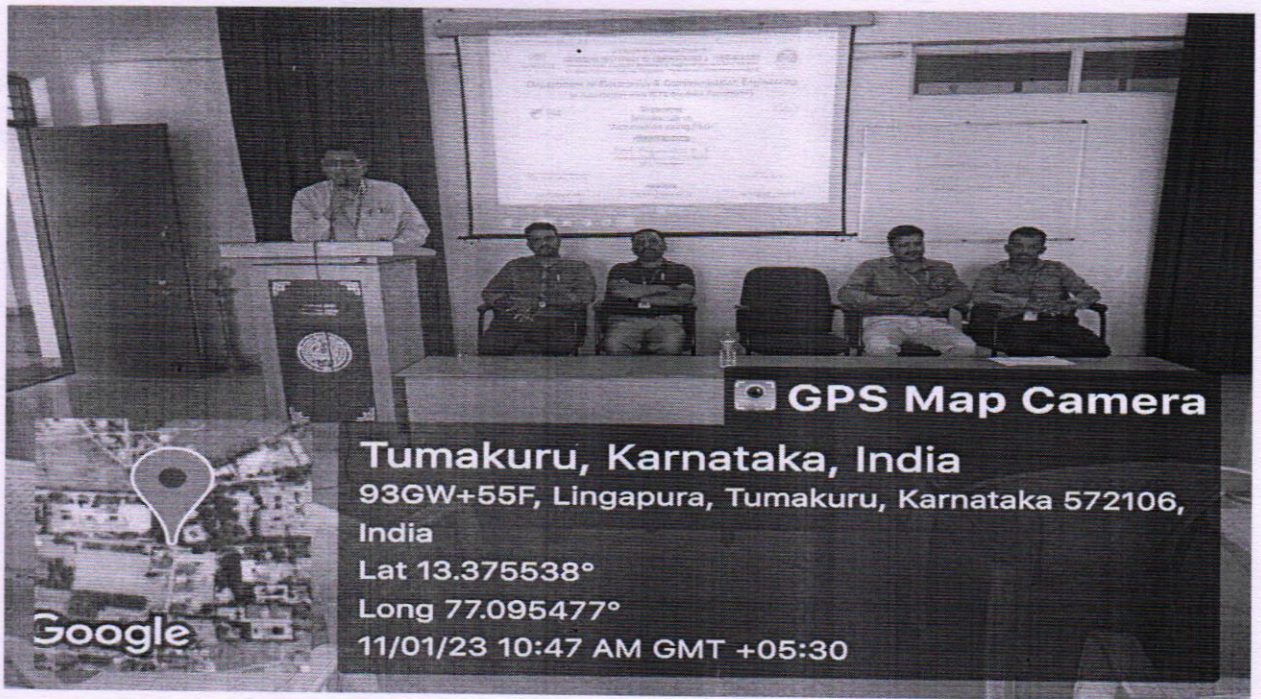
Dr,Pradeep K G M , Associate Professor and event coordinator has addressed vote of thank to resource person , and all faculty members and student.

Second year and Prefinal year were participated in the event and actively interacted with resource person.

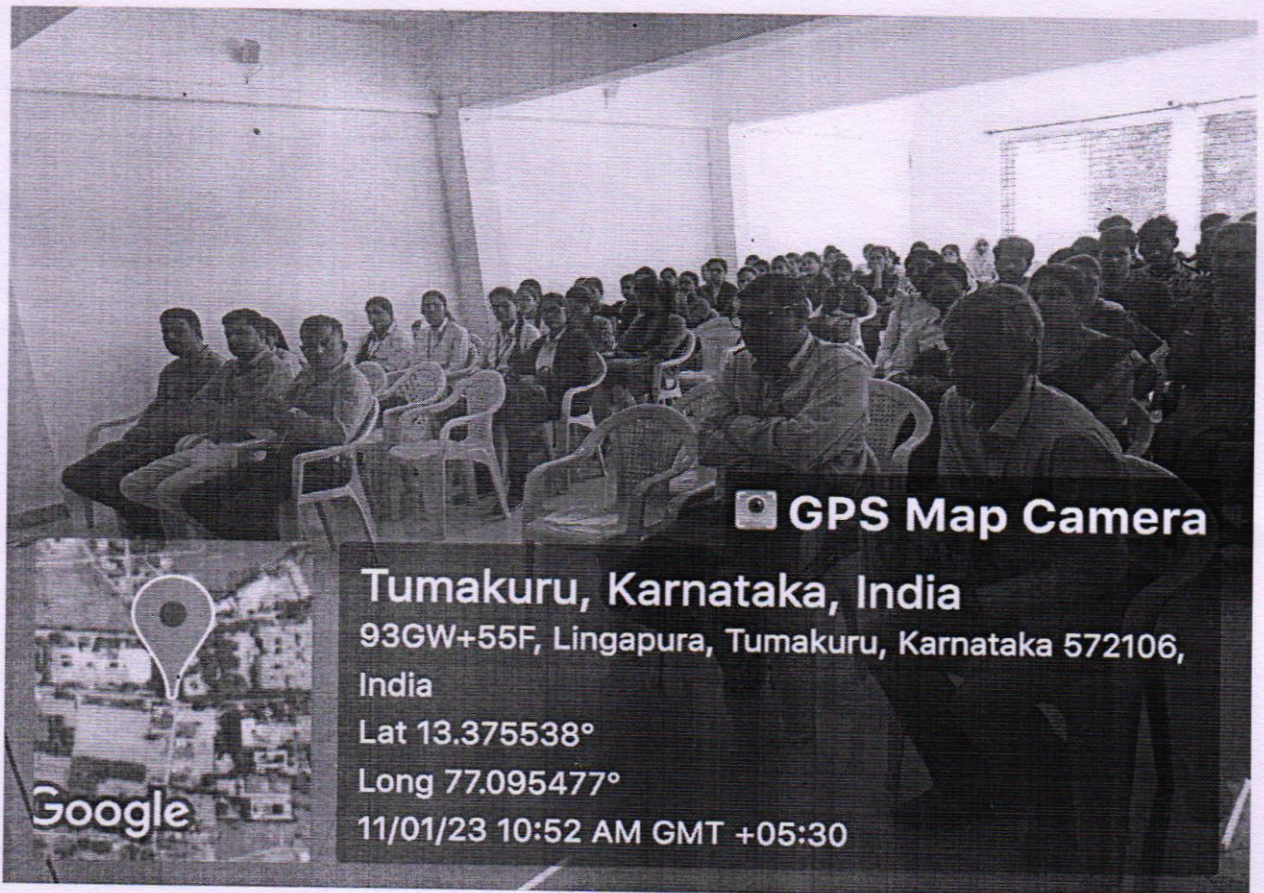

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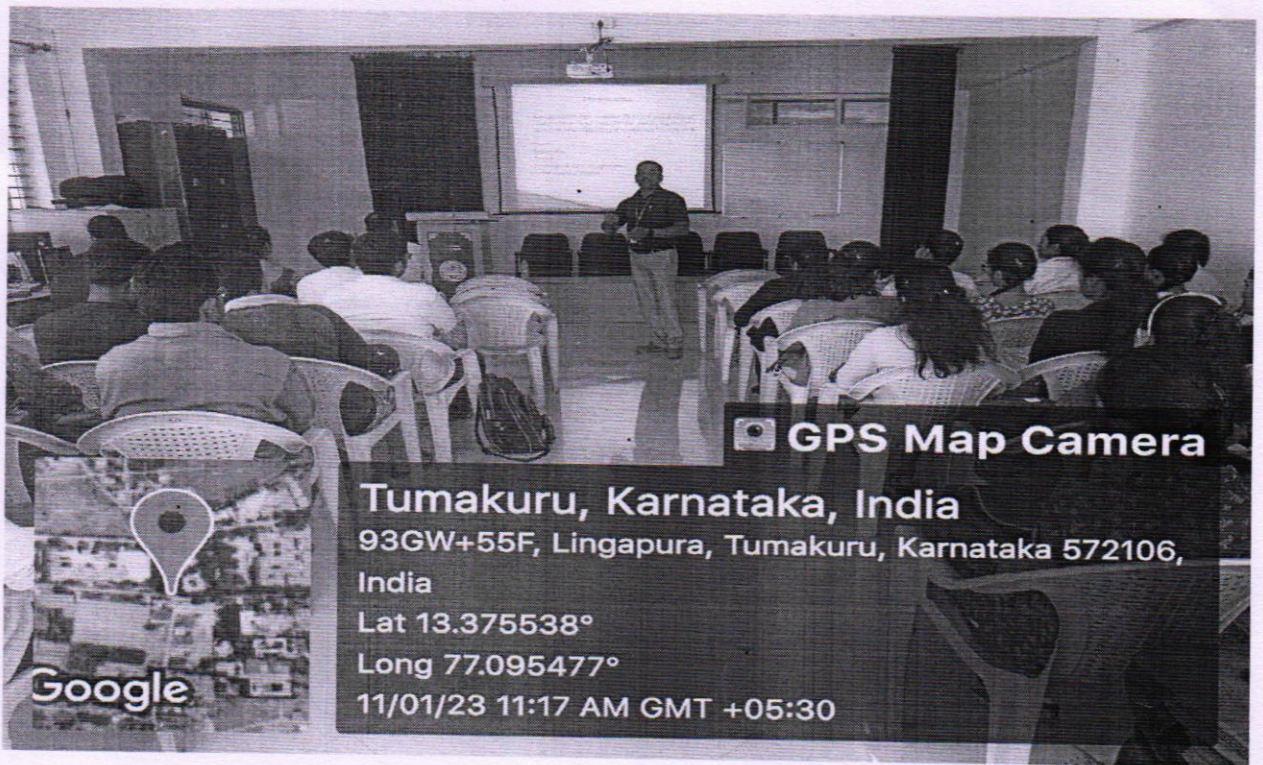

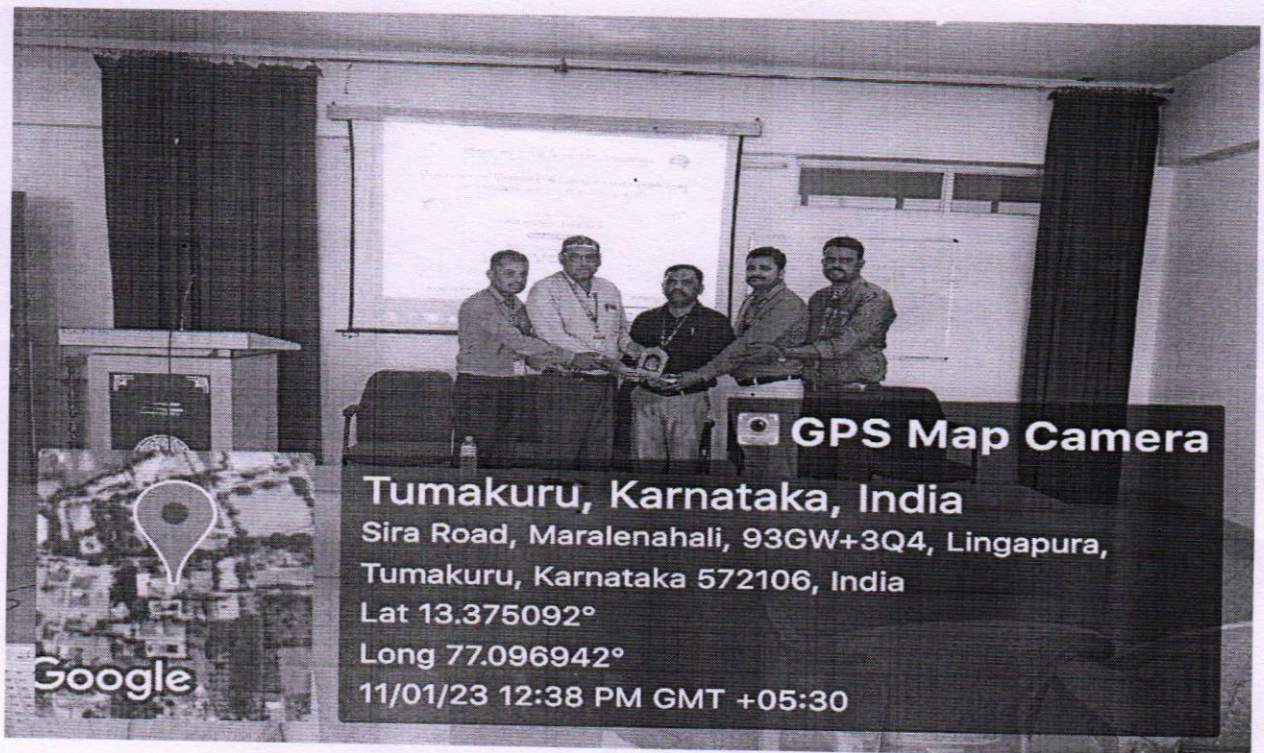
