ABSTRACT

The AICTE Activity Points project has the focus on applying engineering skills to solve the social problems existing in India. The project "**Agri Job Opportunities Platform in Rural Areas**" throws alight on possible opportunity for the engineering solution in the development of Job Opportunities in the Agriculture segment particularly in Rural Areas. The Project is executed in 2 phases, Theoretical and Practical Phase.

In Theoretical Phase, the meaning of Labour, Labourer and its classification were studied. The existence and origin of agriculture labour since the Ancient Period were analyzed. The reason for the existence of gap or differentiation between the agriculture labour and agriculture land owner is studied. The thinking process irrespective of right or wrong happened in the labour and owner segment has contributed to the today's complication in the Agri Labour segment. The government policies supporting agri labourer and owner were studied. The gap existing in policies addressing the labour owner issues were explored.
