Studies

You will be studying towards a Master of Science (120 credits) with a major in Product Development, specialisation in Assistive Technology. More information about your programme and courses can be found at www.ju.se. Further academic questions concerning the programme will be handled by your programme manager upon arrival.

Starting date

The academic year 2023/2024 starts on August 21, 2023 and runs until June 9, 2024. You are expected to arrive either during the weekend before August 21 if you wish to utilise the pick-up service (more information on Arrival/Pick-up will be sent out later) or, at the latest, on August 21 in time for the compulsory roll-call.

Contact admissions.office@ju.se before August 21 if you have a serious conflict to arrive in time.

If you do not attend the compulsory roll-call and have not been granted late arrival by the Admissions Office, you will lose your admission to the programme at Jönköping University.

Tuition fee

The decision on admission is conditional to you paying the first instalment of the tuition fee for your studies. By paying the tuition fee you confirm the offered place. You will therefore receive payment instructions for the fee for the first instalment of the programme tuition fee within a few days. The tuition fee must have reached our bank by the due date on the invoice, so take into account that international bank transfers will take several days. If payment has not arrived by the due date, your admission will be cancelled. If you have any questions about the payment please contact tuition@ju.se
