

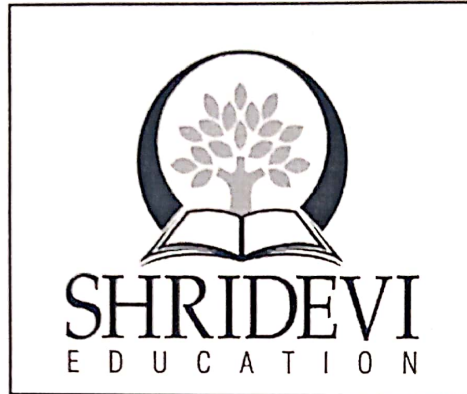

The Council expressed satisfaction over the placement activities for the batch of students of 2020 – 21 and 2021 - 22.

**7. Report on AICTE/VTU LIC Extension of Approval and Affiliation for the year 2022-23.**

Principal informed the GC members that since the admission for EEE and CV has also seen a decline, it was decided to reduce the intake from 45 to 30 in both branches and increase the intake in CSE from existing 90 to 120 as demand for admission to CSE is satisfactory. He also mentioned that due to the move taken last year by reducing intake in ME and adding new course AI & DS the admission to new course AI & Ds was satisfactory. He also mentioned that VTU has issued NoC for reduction of Intake in both EEE and Civil Engineering from 45 to 30 and also has approved the increase in intake of CSE from 90 to 120. The same is applied to both VTU and AICTE for academic year 2022 – 23.

A new Research centre in Electronics & Communication Engineering was proposed by the Department as there are 3 nos. of faculty with Ph.D. and the same has been applied to VTU for academic year 2022 – 23.

It has been proposed to close the research centre in Bio Technology as all courses related to the same has been closed.

- Department of CSE and ECE conducted several Technical Talks.

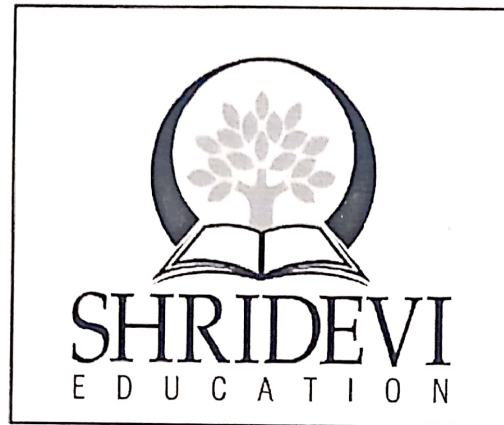

The Institute reopened after the long break due to lockdown and the departments have planned various activities such as Technical talks, symposiums and workshops.



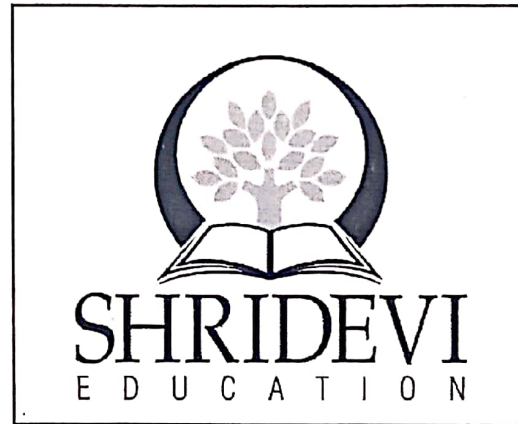

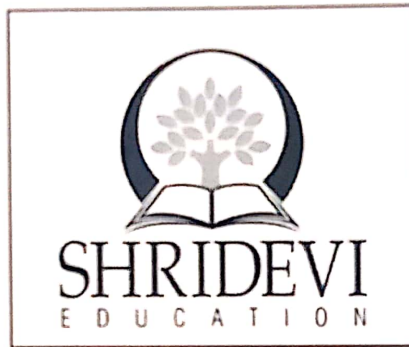

About 65000 students were counseled through telephonic calling by faculty to provide them with admission details and 210 students were admitted due to this effort. Earlier to this faculty had visited about 104 PUC Colleges in and around Tumkur and had collected around 6000 student's data. Very strong marketing campaign was initiated by the management for admissions. However due to poor response and overall drop in the admission to professional courses both at state and national level and due to very severe competition and excessive admissions by private universities and autonomous colleges, students preferred those institutes against affiliated institutes like ours. However, while appreciating efforts of the management and staff for admission process, the GC members emphasized on the fact that quality teaching must be delivered and students must be attracted to the institute with various measures.

Institution: The College Fest "ShriUtsav 2019" was celebrated on 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> March 2019 and Sri Dingri Nagaraj and Bharathi B L were the chief guests. 



✚ Suggested to improve the reach out of social activities like NSS,PMKVY,Swachh bharat abhiyan etc.


