

Policy for award of Management Scholarship & Freeship to students

Shridevi Institute of Engineering & Technology (SIET), Tumakuru, an important educational wing of Shridevi Group of Institutions was established by Sri Shridevi Charitable Trust (R.) (SCT), Tumakuru, in the year 2002 with the sole aim of imparting quality Technical Education. Dr. M. R. Hulinaykar, a doctor by profession, Ex MLC, is the Founder Chairman and Managing Trustee of SCT. Sri Shridevi Charitable Trust (R.) which was started in the year 1992, has established number of educational institutions running various streams of academic institutions to provide quality education for all sections of the society. Since then, the society has rendered the service to the society in the fields of Education & Health by establishing Hospitals & Colleges.

Pursuing the philosophy of continuous learning, the Institution prepares the students to score creditably in the Academic sessions and also encourages them to develop their interpersonal and intra-personal skills and attitudes to approach life with confidence. SIET strives to excel in imparting holistic quality education inculcated with ethical, moral and spiritual values to Engineering and Management Students to make them globally competitive.


The institute through its vision and mission while striving to excel and impart quality education also takes up a large responsibility to cater to the needs of meritorious and socially backward students by providing scholarship and freeship through the trust.

The following are the guidelines followed while granting scholarship and freeship.


I. For students admitted under Management quota:

1. A Scholarship cum Admission test is conducted at the beginning of admission year to identify meritorious students and scholarship for 4 years of study is provided as follows.
 - 1 to 10 Ranks up to Rs. 4,00,000/-
 - 11 to 30 Ranks up to Rs. 3,00,000/-
 - 31 to 100 Ranks up to Rs. 2,00,000/-
 - 101 and above Ranks up to Rs. 1,00,000/-

2. To identify meritorious and socially weaker students, a talent hunt called "Anveshana" is conducted for students of PUC from the district of Tumakuru. The qualified students are provided with coaching and financial help to pursue higher studies and assured of admission in Shirdevi Institute of Engineering and Technology.
 3. The management generally publishes the tuition fee per AY for all courses at the beginning of every AY. All the admission are carried out with this standardised fee structure. However the principal and the management are given the liberty to offer freeship to the meritorious and socially backward students to an extent of 50% per annum. For example, for CSE the published fee is Rs. 3,00,000/- per annum, freeship is provided upto Rs. 1,50,000/-. Similarly for other core branches the fee would be either charged at government prescribed fee or even lower based on need.
- II. For students admitted under Government quota:
Students who opt our college under Government quota are provided with freeship to an extent of other fee and skill lab fee amounting to Rs. 30,000 per year.
- III. Award of scholarship to meritorious students for securing higher GPA in their university examinations:
All the students who secured SGPA of 9.0 and above are awarded Rs. 6,000/- scholarship every semester. For students securing SGPA between 7.5 to 9.0 scholarship are provided in the form of refunding the NPTEL registration fee up to Rs. 2,000/- upon successful completion of NPTEL course.
- IV. Meritorious awards and sponsorships are also given to successful students in the areas of sports, cultural activities, projects, hackathons, participation in State and National level events etc.
