

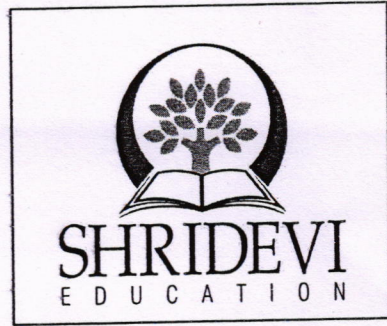
Governing Council Meetings

Governing Council means Managing Trustee and body of persons permitted to establish and maintain the Trust Institutions, which is a governing body to which the affairs of all the institutions of the Trust are entrusted.

The Duties and the code of conduct for the Governing Council

It shall be the duty of the Governing Council.-To uphold the dignity and integrity of the Trust. To ensure that none of the employees of the institution engage in private tuition, anti-social activities or active politics. To follow the curricula, syllabi and textbooks for any course of instruction prescribed by the Government/ University, RGUHS, ect Medical Council of India, Visvesvaraya Technical University from time to time. Governing Council shall maintain Accounts and Audits of all institutions. The Governing Council shall have power to appoint head of the institution and take disciplinary action against him and have powers of Retrenchment of any employees and is superior to the Managing Committee of the institutions in all matters. The Managing Trustee shall be the president of the Governing Council and have all administrative, controlling and financial powers vested with him.

4. Closure of 2 Courses and Introduction of New Course

Principal explained GC Members that there is zero admission in B.E Mechanical Engineering and very less admissions in Electrical and Electronics Engineering for the year 2022-23. It was also informed that in the previous academic years the admission to these branches were very less than the approved intake. Hence Principal requested to GC Members for approval of Closure of above 2 courses and introduction of new course in Emerging Area "B.E in Computer Science and Engineering (Cyber Security)".

Governing Council approved and resolved for closure of the Courses B.E in Mechanical Engineering (intake 30) and B.E in Electrical and Electronics (intake 30) for admission from the year 2023-24. And introduction of New Course "B.E in Computer Science and Engineering (Cyber Security)" with intake of 60 from the year 2023-24. Further GC members suggested the principal to apply to VTU/AICTE for the above changes.


The Principal welcomed all the Governing Council Members and requested the Hon'ble Chairman to preside over the 25th Governing Council Meeting.


The Council expressed satisfaction over the placement activities for the batch of students of 2020 – 21 and 2021 - 22.

Report on AICTE/VTU LIC Extension of Approval and Affiliation for the year 2022-23.

Principal informed the GC members that since the admission for EEE and CV has also seen a decline, it was decided to reduce the intake from 45 to 30 in both branches and increase the intake in CSE from existing 90 to 120 as demand for admission to CSE is satisfactory. He also mentioned that due to the move taken last year by reducing intake in ME and adding new course AI & DS the admission to new course AI & Ds was satisfactory. He also mentioned that VTU has issued NoC for reduction of Intake in both EEE and Civil Engineering from 45 to 30 and also has approved the increase in intake of CSE from 90 to 120. The same is applied to both VTU and AICTE for academic year 2022 – 23.

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8. Report on Institution and Departmental Activities



- Department of CSE and ECE conducted several Technical Talks.



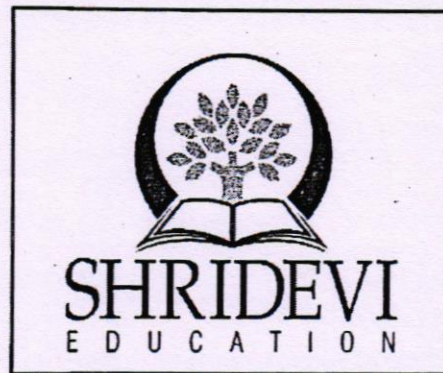



1. Welcome and Brief Introduction


The Principal welcomed all the Governing Council Members and requested the Hon'ble Chairman to preside over the 24th Governing Council Meeting.




More than 20 campus Placement Drives have been organized and about 49 students have been selected.
